RE: MRB Runway 08-26 CLOSURE SCHEDULE – AIRFIELD LIGHTING/SIGNAGE PROJECT UPDATE

After consultation with our project engineers and contractors – we've learned of a need to extend our nightly, mid-week runway closures through 8/20/2022 to complete the project due to several factors including the limitations and losses of night-work opportunities.

It's also likely the **ILS-related navigation aids will remain in their deactivated state until no earlier than 08/31/2022** Note: RNAV arrival/departures procedures will remain operational. We may also seek to cancel these runway closure NOTAMs and restore the ILS system sooner than 08/31 if possible, such as if the project progresses faster than anticipated.
